Sorting Dual Stream

If you use the local drop-sites or have dual stream recycling at your curb, here's how you sort

BIN #1: PAPER



**Newspaper | Magazines | Office Paper
Paperboard**

BIN #2: COMMINGLE



Glass | Aluminum | Tin | Plastic

Cardboard can only be recycled at a drop-site and has its own marked bin

Compost

If you have curbside compost or use a drop-site this is what goes in the bin

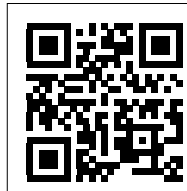


Quick, Simple Answers to Recycling Questions
